Rorate Caeli Mass

From the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe:

The moving power of the candlelight in the darkness made a profound impression. "It makes us calmer and more focused on what's going on," commented Fr. Pio Vottola, one of the Norbertine Fathers at the Shrine. "You can't be distracted." He added, "I think anybody would enjoy it. Even somebody that wasn't Christian could walk into a Rorate Mass and think, something beautiful is going on. He also remarked on the fitting symbolism of the Rorate Mass as an Advent tradition. He noted that in this season, "all the readings talk about the Light of the World," and that here, the faithful took part in "a Mass that shows that... [It] starts in the dark, with the candles, and as the Mass unfolds, and the heavenly liturgy comes down to earth... more light, the sunlight. 


