#### When does the Christmas Season End?

The Christmas Season ends with Candlemas. The Church has traditionally celebrated the Christmas season for forty days, from Christmas Day to February 2, which is the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, also called Candlemas. There is a Fourth -Century A.D. eyewitness account of the Feast of the Forty Days by a pilgrim named Egeria. In the beginning of the Christian era, Christ's birth was celebrated, along with the Epiphany, on January 6, so Egeria wrote of a procession and Mass in Jerusalem on the fortieth day after Epiphany. When Christmas was later moved to December 25, the date of the Feast of the Forty Days was moved back also, to February 2. Sometime before the Eighth Century, February 2 also began to be celebrated as the Marian Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary.


