Little Lesson in Church Music

The "Propers" of a Mass consist of the Introit, Gradual, Tract, Alleluia, Sequence, Offertory and Communion antiphons. In this case, the English word proper comes from Latin through French, and the word means something like "pertaining to something specific". If we said "that's my proper toothbrush", we would mean it belonged to no one else. Interestingly enough, however, in the season after Pentecost, several of the Propers show up at other times: they use the same music and the same text. For example, the Offertory for Sexagesima Sunday is also the Offertory for the 6th Sunday after Pentecost, but we won't hear it this year because of the External Solemntiy of the Feast of Ss. Peter and Paul. The Offertory for the 3rd Sunday of Lent is also the Offertory for the 9th Sunday after Pentecost. The Offertory for the 1st Sunday of Advent is also the Offertory for the 10th Sunday after Pentecost. The Offertory for Ash Wednesday is also the Offertory for the 11th Sunday after Pentecost.


