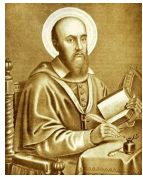

Do You Know About the Liturgy?

As early as the third century, certain roles of service, including deacon, subdeacon, lector, and acolyte, were present in the church. These orders over time became linked to preparation for the priesthood and were divided between “minor orders” (porter, exorcist, lector, and acolyte) and “major orders” (subdeacon, deacon, and priest). The roles are varied, as examples, the Porter was given a key, and as the doorkeeper, responsible for opening and closing the church and guarding the door during the celebration of Mass, and the Lector, a book with the right to read certain passages of Holy Scripture when ordered by the priest or bishop. Each order was received and its function performed for a suitable time before a man was ordained to the priesthood.

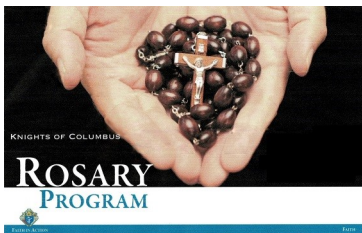
