

BUILDING OUR PROVINCIAL SHRINE OF CHRIST THE KING

Work Accomplished

Despite the coming of winter weather, work continues unabated in our Shrine restoration project! Although due to supply chain delays we have been waiting on the necessary PEX tubing for the future radiant heating to arrive, other work has been done, notably the placing of a moisture barrier over the gravel base in the nave which now awaits insulation and the arrival of the radiant heat systems.



Work has also begun in earnest in the basement of the church, which will house the Shrine's public restrooms as well as mechanical rooms for the heating, electricity, and plumbing. First, the floor was excavated and several footings removed to make room for the future plumbing and electrical work.

Then the plumbers began their work, installing all new systems inside and digging up and repairing damaged plumbing outside. Once the plumbing has been inspected, it will be covered up and the electrical conduit can be placed before finally the basement floor slab is poured.
