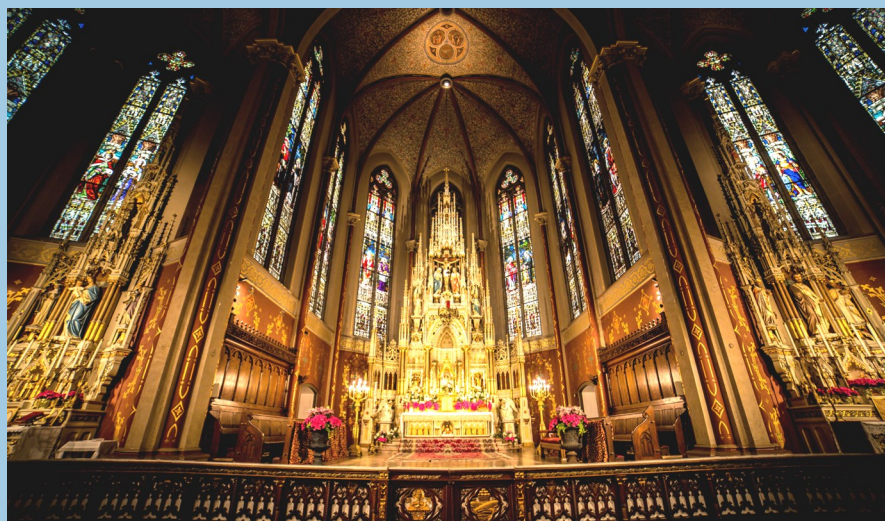

PLENARY INDULGENCE AVAILABLE FOR ASSISTING AT MASS ON THE FEAST OF ST. FRANCIS DE SALES

WHAT IS A PLENARY INDULGENCE?

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

HOW TO OBTAIN THE INDULGENCE?

A plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day. In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace when the indulgenced work is completed (the indulgenced work for the Feast of St. Francis de Sales is assisting here or at another Institute church or chapel at Holy Mass):

- Have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin
- Have sacramentally confessed their sins
- Receive the Holy Eucharist
- Pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.


