Struggle with sight-reading? NO PROBLEM! 24/7 Practice aids (NEW)! The oratory now has a membership with Cantamus™, a Barcelona-based software application that renders music scores into digitally-sampled human voices singing the part. Cantamus™ allows users to set volume levels of each part, allowing individual parts to be selectively louder or softer to aid learning. If you have ever suffered anxiety over reading notes, Cantamus™ will change your life!

Ordinary Choir (NEW): The Ordinary of Mass is the set of prayers sung at every High Mass: Kyrie, Gloria, Sanctus, Agnus Dei, and Ite Missa Est. Simpler, shorter, and more frequently recurring than the Proper of Mass, the Ordinary provides a way to participate in choir without the stress of complex music. With same-day rehearsals, no additional weekly commutes are needed. Supported by section leaders, members do not need to know how to read music to start. Drawing confidence from strength-in-numbers, this new choir must be large to succeed -- so help spread the word! Ordinary Choir begins Sunday, September 1.

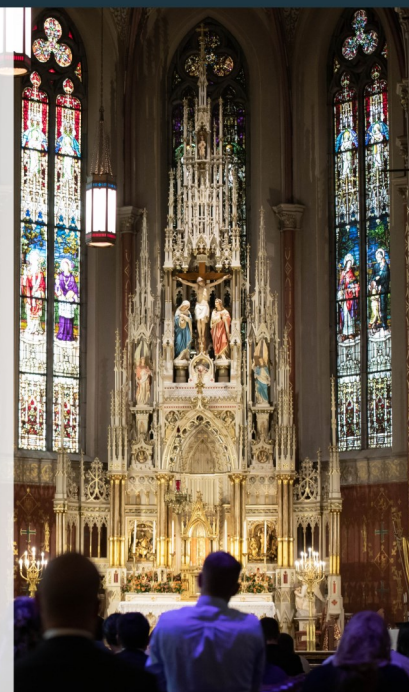

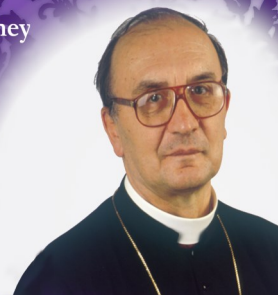
