

Struggle with sight-reading? NO PROBLEM! 24/7 Practice aids (NEW)! The oratory now has a membership with CantamusTM, a Barcelona-based software application that renders music scores into digitally-sampled human voices singing the part. CantamusTM allows users to set volume levels of each part, allowing individual parts to be selectively louder or softer to aid learning. If you have ever suffered anxiety over reading notes, CantamusTM will change your life!


Ordinary Choir (NEW): The Ordinary of Mass is the set of prayers sung at every High Mass: Kyrie, Gloria, Sanctus, Agnus Dei, and Ite Missa Est. Simpler, shorter, and more frequently recurring than the Proper of Mass, the Ordinary provides a way to participate in choir without the stress of complex music. With same-day rehearsals, no additional weekly commutes are needed. Supported by section leaders, members do not need to know how to read music to start. Drawing confidence from strength-in-numbers, this new choir must be large to succeed -- so help spread the word! Ordinary Choir begins Sunday, September 1.

Children's Choir sings The Lord of the Rings: Choral music from Howard Shore's score to Peter Jackson's The Lord of the Rings originally performed by the London Oratory children's choir will be featured alongside other dramatic choral works at the annual fundraising gala, including "Brigadoon", as the oratory drums up support for the choir's music pilgrimage to Ireland Summer 2026. Rehearsals are Saturdays 9:15-10:15am beginning August 31. Registration closes September 7

Chant Class Returns: Created for enthusiasts, converts, clerics and candidates, the weekly chant class is the absolute simplest starting point for anyone looking to establish, refresh, or clarify their fluency in the Church's primary musical medium, whether or not they sing in a choir. Visual and demonstration-led, the learning environment is paced and supported by take-home materials provided. Rather than charging tuition, students are encouraged to make a donation to the oratory. Class meets Tuesdays 7:45-8:45pm beginning August 27.

Christ the King Music Festival - Sing with orchestra! Honoring this year's Feast of Christ the King October 27, the festival choir and orchestra will feature Franz Joseph Haydn's epic "Missa angustiis", aka "Lord Nelson Mass."
