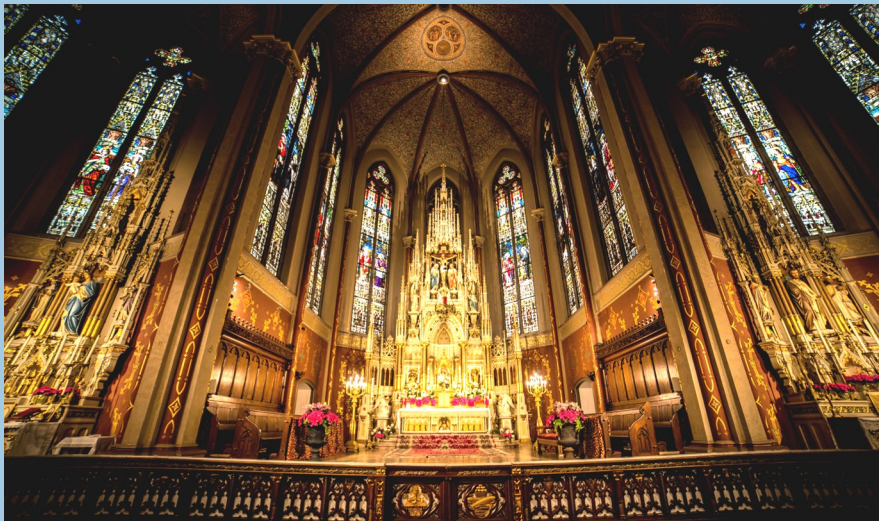

## WEDDING BANNNS

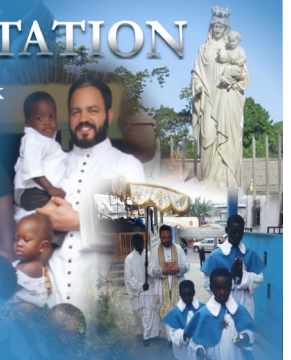

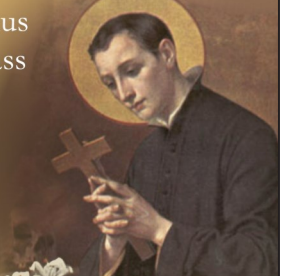


