

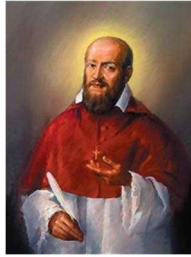

This Saturday, Join fellow Catholics for a walking pilgrimage to Shrines of the Blessed Virgin Mary!

You don't have to go to France; it's right here in Pt. Arthur March 4. It will include the Traditional Latin Mass, the Most Holy Rosary, Way of the Cross, and more! A moving spiritual journey.....

Mass kickoff at 9 a.m. at Our Lady of Guadalupe. Confessions—45 minutes before mass. Intermediate stops at holy sites; end about 3:15 pm.

We provide bread, water, police escort, a van to rest, snacks by KCs, optional shuttles at the beginning, and an easy time to pray and reflect on the itinerary. Lenten Fast: (Fridays and Ash Wednesday)

-The law of abstinence forbids the use of meat. This does not apply to dairy products, eggs, or condiments and shortening made from animal fat.

-The law of fasting allows only one full meal a day and two smaller meals. The two smaller meals should not equal the quantity of the main meal (which in the United States is customarily observed as the evening dinner).

-Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed, including milk and fruit juices.

-Fish and all cold-blooded animals may be eaten (e.g., frogs, clams, turtles, etc.).
