

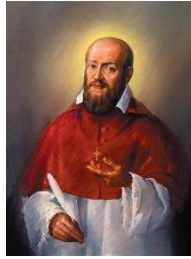

### **NO Adoration this week.**

**Ascension of Our Lord:** Thursday is the Ascension of Our Lord. Mass will be at 6:00 PM.

**First Communion:** Class will be this Tuesday at 5 PM.

**Confirmation:** Certificates will be available for pick-up starting this Sunday 5/22.

**Rogation Days:** Rogation Days are days of prayer and fasting. We pray for a good harvest and protection from hurricanes and other natural disasters. Rogation comes from the Latin word rogare, which means to ask. They occur on April 25th and the 3 days before the Ascension.

There will be a procession with the Litany of Saints prayed prior to the Noon Mass for these 3 days. If you cannot make it to the procession and Mass, Canon Moreau suggests you pray the Litany of Saints at home. Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday are Rogation Days.
