2023-2024 Insurance Premium

Our insurance policy renewed in April 2023 and as expected with quite an increase in the annual premium. The updated premium is \$68,427. While shocking to all, we know that we cannot directly absorb this cost. However by breaking it down into weekly goals, it seems to be more attainable.

We need to collect a minimum of \$1350 per week to pay the premium. If 27 families could devote \$50 per week towards the insurance premium, we can take one less bill off the books.
