

### FYI for Mass from Schola:

1. For those who would like to sing along with the choir for parts of the Mass such as the ordinary, it would be appropriate to alternate men's voices with women's voices, as the choir does. If the choir is alternating high voices with low voices, those singing along in the pews should sing along with their proper voice part.

2. During the recessional hymn at the end of Mass, the congregation needs only to stand as long as the priest is processing through the nave, rather than as long as the choir is singing. Once the priest exits through the doors, the faithful are free to kneel and begin their thanksgiving even if the choir is still singing.
