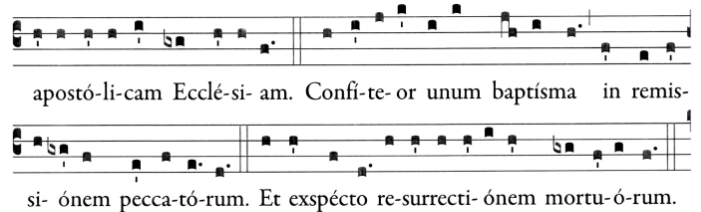
Insurance Update
