In preparation for the Jubilee Year, His Excellency Bishop Provost will release a Decree on the First Sunday of Advent to inform the faithful of ways to participate in the Jubilee Year locally. The commencement of the Jubilee will begin with an opening Mass on the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph on December 29, 2024 at 9:30AM at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Lake Charles.
