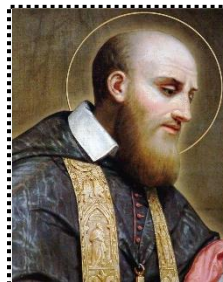

That give an unmeasurable help to Abbe Kevin and myself, in the preparation of Memorial Day.

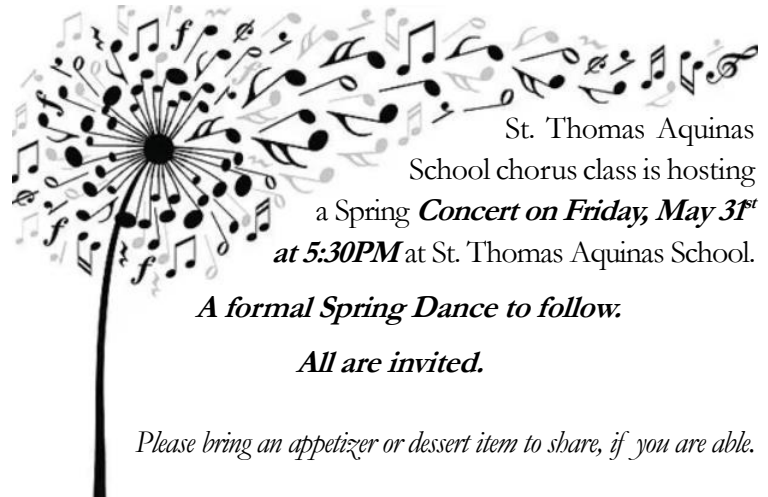


Memorial Day:

Tarcisius's Teaching. Which Missal? -5

Another liturgical conflict arrives this week: the *Vigil of Pentecost*. Before 1955, the Vigil of Pentecost was very similar to the Easter Vigil. The Mass was preceded with 6 readings (12 for Easter) and we proceed also to the consecration of the Baptismal Water, then Litanies, then Mass... The post 1955 Missal have not the full liturgy for this day. So, if you do not have a pre-55 missal or booklet, you will need one of Canon's Dumain print-out...
