Novena of Prayer for Vocations to priesthood and clerical oblatehood.

*The novena starts on **September 29, feast of St. Michael the Archangel**, and continues to **October 7, the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary**. These dates have been carefully chosen to frame this novena around St. Michael, protector of Holy Church, and Our Lady, who plays a crucial role in forming good and holy priests and clerical oblates.*

*Within this span of dates are the feasts of **St. Jerome**, patron of scholars and students and an aide for the intellectual formation of the members of the Institute; the **Holy Guardian Angels**, who protect our priests, oblates and seminarians; **St. Therese of Lisieux**, secondary patroness of the Institute and patroness of missions who need priests to evangelize; **St. Francis of Assisi**, who is patron of Italy and watches over our International Seminary of St. Philip Neri where future priests are formed. The closing day on the feast of **Our Lady of the Rosary**, highlights her role as mother of priests and the importance of the Rosary in spiritual formation.*

I pray that with your help and your fervent prayers, we will be able to storm Heaven and to beseech God for the graces to form holy priests and oblates in the service of Christ the King.
