All Souls' Octave, November 1-8:

Plenary Indulgences:

An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from November 1-8; on other days of the year, it is a partial indulgence.

To gain a plenary indulgence, in addition to excluding all attachment to sin, even venial sin, it is necessary to perform the indulgent work and fulfill the following three conditions: Confession, Communion, and prayer for the intention of the Sovereign Pontiff.

Let's empty the Purgatory!
