

# Mass Intention Policy for the year 2023

We are accepting the first round of Mass intentions for next year 2023, preferably without any specific date for the ease of scheduling by the Rector. For posterity and archiving reasons, Mass intention requests must be submitted (typed or handwritten) in person to the Rector. Electronic (e-mail) requests will be no longer be accepted. For the first round, in order to accommodate everyone's requests, we are accepting a maximum limit of five intentions (only one of those can be requested on a Sunday) per registered parishioner & once we receive most of the requests, we will announce a second round of Mass requests later in 2023 in order to accept more, if the calendar permits. The minimum stipend for a weekday Mass is \$10 for each intention. Due to the more celebratory nature of Sundays, a larger stipend may be given (these stipends, or whichever the requestor gives, directly benefits the priest celebrating the Mass for his livelihood). In addition, Mass intention requests must now be accompanied with the stipend in order for the requests be actually reserved & scheduled in the Mass intention book. Otherwise, they will not be accepted. Please make your Mass Stipend payable to
