St. Francis de Sales Sermon from July 2, 1621

Our Lord established three unions in the sacred
Virgin Our Lady... The first is that of the
Divine Nature with the human nature in her
sacred womb, which is so elevated a mystery.

The second union which He effected in Our
Lady was that of maternity with virginity, a
union which is absolutely outside the course
of nature, for it unites two things which it is
impossible to find together in nature.

The third union is that of a very exalted
charity and a very profound humility.

What is the visitation of Our Lady to Elizabeth
if not a meeting of humility and charity? As
soon as she saw herself Mother of God, she
humbled herself by immediately setting out on
the road to go and assist her cousin Elizabeth.
