# **SOLEMNITY OF ST. JOSEPH**

Introit: Ps. 32, 20, 21. The Lord is our helper and protector: in Him our heart shall rejoice, and in His holy name we have trusted. Alleluia, alleluia. Ps. 79, 2. Give ear, O Thou that rulest Israel: Thou that leadest Joseph like a sheep. V. Glory.

**Collect:** O God, Who, in Thine unspeakable providence, didst deign to choose blessed Joseph for the spouse of Thy most holy Mother, grant, we beseech Thee, that, venerating him on earth as our protector, we may deserve to have him for our intercessor in heaven. Who livest.

**Epistle: Gen. 49, 22-26.** Joseph is a growing son, a growing son and comely to behold: the daughters run to and fro upon the wall. But they that held darts provoked him, and quarreled with him and envied him. His bow rested upon the strong, and the bands of his arms and hands were loosed, by the hands of the mighty one of Jacob: thence he came forth a pastor, the stone of Israel. The God of thy father shall be thy helper, and the Almighty shall bless thee with the blessings of heaven above, with the blessings of the deep that lieth beneath, with the blessings of the breasts and of the womb. The blessings of thy father are strengthened with the blessings of his fathers: until the desire of the everlasting hills shall come; may they be upon the head of Joseph, and upon the crown of the Nazarite among his brethren.

**Alleluia:** Alleluia, alleluia. V. In whatever tribulation they shall cry to me, I will hear them, and be their protector always. Alleluia. V. Grant, O Joseph, that ever secure under thy patronage, we may pass our lives without guilt. Alleluia.

Gospel: Luke 3, 21-23. At that time, it came to pass, when all the people were baptized, that Jesus also being baptized and praying, heaven was opened: and the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape as a dove upon Him: and a voice came from Heaven: Thou art My beloved Son, in Thee, I am well pleased. And Jesus Himself was beginning about the age of thirty years: being (as it was supposed) the son of Joseph.

**Offertory: Ps. 147, 12-13.** Praise the Lord, O Jerusalem, because He hath strengthened the bolts of thy gates: He hath blessed thy children within thee. Alleluia, alleluia.

**Secret:** Supported by the patronage of the spouse of Thy most holy Mother, we ask Thy clemency, O Lord, to make our hearts despise all earthly things and with perfect charity love Thee, the true God. Who livest.

**Preface of St. Joseph:** It is truly meet and just, right and profitable for us, at all times, and in all places, to give thanks to Thee, O holy Lord, Father almighty, eternal God, and on the festivity of St. Joseph to magnify Thee with due praise, to bless and proclaim Thee. The just man who was given by Thee as a spouse to the Virgin Mother of God, and was placed over Thy Family as a faithful and prudent servant; so that taking the place of the eternal Father, he might guard the only-begotten Son conceived by the shadow of the Holy Ghost, Jesus Christ, Our Lord, through Whom the angels praise Thy majesty, the dominions worship it, the powers are in awe, the heavens and the heavenly hosts and the blessed seraphim join together in celebrating their joy. With these, we pray Thee, join our own voices also, while we sing with lowly praise: Holy, holy...

**Communion: Matt. 1, 16.** But Jacob begat Joseph, the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus, Who is called Christ. Alleluia, alleluia.

**Postcommunion:** Refreshed at the fountain of divine blessing, we beseech Thee, O Lord, our God, as Thou dost make us to rejoice in the protection of blessed Joseph, so to make us also, by his merits and intercession, partakers of his heavenly glory. Through our Lord.

If this is your first time here, we look forward to meeting you. We have a social hour with coffee and doughnuts after the 10:30am High Mass. Please join us.

Holy Mass here is celebrated in the traditional Latin Rite. This was the form of worship in use in the Western world from antiquity until 1970. If you are unfamiliar with the traditional Latin Mass, do not hesitate to approach the priests with any questions you may have.

All practicing Catholics in the state of grace are invited to approach the altar rail for Holy Communion. In the traditional Roman Rite, Holy Communion is received kneeling (unless you are impaired from doing so) and on the tongue. The mouth should be open with the tongue slightly extended. You do not look at the priest and you do not say Amen.

The baptistery in the back of the church functions as a crying room during the Mass. Please feel free to make use of it when you have a crying child by exiting quietly down one of the side aisles.

If you are not Catholic, we invite you to learn about our faith. The Church was founded over 2000 years ago by Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. If you are interested in becoming Catholic or learning more about the Catholic faith, please do not hesitate to contact us. The priests of the Oratory offer individual instruction. We look forward to hearing from you.
