MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

HERESIES of the 16th century preached a distorted view of Christianity that substituted for God's love and sacrifice of His son for all men, the frightful notion that a whole section of humanity was damned no matter what -- quite the opposite of the modernistic view that all are saved. The Church countered the heresy with the infinite love of our Savior who died on the cross for all men. The whole divine plan for the redemption of the world in and through Christ, reveals to us the love God bears us in having given us His Son; Christ is the true paschal Lamb, sacrificed for the salvation of the world, dying on the cross for love of us. But the duty of reparation is imposed upon us as a response to this love of Christ, which takes on the expiation of our sins. A "great apparition" took place on June 16, 1675, during the octave of the Feast of Corpus Christi, and is the source of the modern Feast of the Sacred Heart. In that vision, Christ asked St. Margaret Mary Alacoque to request that the Feast of the Sacred Heart be celebrated on the Friday after the octave of the Feast of Corpus Christi, in reparation for the ingratitude of men for the sacrifice that Christ had made for them. First celebrated in France, the feast was extended to the universal Church in 1856 by Pius IX. In preparation for so great a feast,

EXT. SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART



INTROIT. Ps. 32, 11, 19. The thoughts of His heart to all generations: to deliver their souls from death and feed them in famine. Ps. 32, 1. Rejoice in the Lord, O ye just, praise becometh the upright. V. Glory.

PRAYER. O God, who, in the Heart of thy Son, wounded by our sins, hast deigned mercifully to bestow infinite treasures of love upon us; grant, we beseech Thee, that as we offer Him the faithful service of our devotion, we may also make worthy reparation. Through the same.

EPISTLE. Eph. 3, 8-19. Brethren: To me, the least of all the saints, is given this grace, to preach among the gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ; and to enlighten all men, that they may see what is the dispensation of the mystery which hath been hidden from eternity in God, who created all things: that the manifold wisdom of God may be made known to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places through the Church: according to the eternal purpose, which he made in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him. For this cause I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, of whom all paterernity in heaven and earth is named; that he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened by his Spirit with might unto the inward man; that Christ may dwell by faith in your hearts; that being rooted and founded in charity, you may be able to comprehend, with all the saints, what is the breadth, and length, and height, and depth: to know also the charity of Christ, which surpasseth all understanding, that you may be filled unto all the fullness of God.

GRADUAL. Ps. 24, 8-9. The Lord is sweet and righteous, therefore he will give a law to sinners in the way. He will guide the mild in judgment, he will teach the meek his ways.

ALLELUIA. Alleluia, alleluia. Matt. 11, 29. Take up my yoke upon you and learn of me, because I am meek and humble

of heart, and you shall find rest to your souls. Alleluia.

GOSPEL. John 19, 31-37. At that time, the Jews (because it was the Parasceve) that the bodies might not remain upon the cross on the Sabbath-day (for that was a great Sabbath-day) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away. The soldiers therefore came, and they broke the legs of the first, and of the other that was crucified with him. But after they were come to Jesus, when they saw that he was already dead, they did not break his legs, but one of the soldiers with a spear opened his side, and immediately there came out blood and water. And he that saw it hath given testimony; and his testimony is true. And he knoweth that he saith true, that you also may believe. For these things were done that the Scripture might be fulfilled: You shall not break a bone of him. And again another Scripture saith: They shall look on him whom they pierced.

OFFERTORY. Ps. 68, 21. My heart hath expected reproach and misery, and I looked for one that would grieve together with me and there was none; and I sought one that would console me and I found none.

SECRET. Look, we beseech Thee, O Lord, on the unspeakable charity of the Heart of thy beloved Son: that what we offer up may be in your sight an accepted gift and the expiation of our sins. Through the same.

COMMUNION. John 19, 34. One of the soldiers with a spear opened his side, and immediately there came out blood and water.

POSTCOMMUNION. May thy holy mysteries, O Lord Jesus, give us holy fervor; that by it perceiving the sweetness of thy most loving Heart, we may learn to despise earthly things and to love those of heaven. Who livest.

Many families chose this time for the Enthronement Ceremony to be performed by the head of the household or the parish priest if possible. And of course, the monthly devotion to the Sacred Heart on First Fridays is a beautiful way to honor the Sacred Heart.
