Greetings from your friends at the Shrine of Christ the King in Woodlawn! The annual feast of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary on October 7 reminds us of the tragic fire which gutted our church home on this same day in 2015. Three years have elapsed since that sad day, but the profound gratitude of our community for all of you is ever fresh and heartfelt. From the very day of the fire, you welcomed our congregation into your beautiful church home with open arms and gracious hearts. We will always be mindful of your remarkable charity and thoughtful kindness in our hour of greatest need.

Thanks be to God, the shingles are now being installed on the new steel structure of our roof, thousands of bricks have been replaced and tuckpointed, while we have been able to reach our \$3 million goal for Phase 1 of the restoration project. Please kindly continue to pray for us as we prepare to enter the project's 2nd phase, which aims to install the necessary mechanical systems and windows so that the building can receive an occupancy permit from the City. We are relying upon the Divine Providence of our Heavenly Father for the \$3-\$4 million which will be needed for us to get back home.

Despite all of the challenges of this time of rebuilding, the ongoing hospitality and gracious welcome of you generous neighbors continue to inspire and encourage us to press on. May God bless and reward you all through the intercession of Our Lady of the Rosary especially as you celebrate the 150th anniversary of your parish. Extending our congratulations and best wishes on his happy occasion for your community, we assure each and every one of you of our prayers for you and your intentions.
