Report from the Project Manager, the Reverend Canon Matthew Weaver:

Our Lord is truly risen! Indeed, the restoration of the National Shrine of Christ the King is well underway. Thanks to the tremendous generosity and dedication of many friends and benefactors across the country, the Institute of Christ the King has been blessed to secure funds for the completion of Phase I in this monumental undertaking. As we continue to raise funds for Phase II, already in progress, I would like to tell you of the immediate projects we have in line:

- Restoration of the 12 original steel window frames (*currently underway*): **funding complete**
- Installation of 1/4" laminated replacement glass (*currently underway*): **funding complete**
- Interior mechanical, electrical and plumbing engineering and design: \$60,000 needed
- Preparation of basement for new restrooms and mechanical rooms: \$30,000 needed
- Insulation of ceiling with high-efficiency closed-cell spray insulation: \$120,000 needed
