A blessing for our times!

From May 3rd, feast of the *Invention of the Holy Cross*, when the true Cross was discovered in 326 by Helen, mother of the Emperor Constantine, through September 14th, feast of *Exaltation of the Holy Cross*, when the Cross was taken back by emperor Heraclius after it had fallen into the hands of the Persian emperor Chosroes II in 614, **every Friday** is given a special blessing using a **relic of the True Cross** of Our Lord Jesus asking God's protection against violent storms, bad weather, either in nature itself or spiritually in our souls.

We beseech Thee, O Almighty God, through the intercession of Holy Mary, the Mother of God, of the holy angels, patriarchs, prophets, apostles, martyrs, confessors, virgins, widows, and of all Thy saints that Thou show us Thy continuing protection, permit tranquil winds, and also pour out to us, Thy unworthy servants, Thy safety from heaven above against lightning strikes and violent storms, and that Thou remain always protective of the human race and crush down the aerial powers by the right hand of Thy power.
