SHRINE RESTORATION - LATEST UPDATE

Windows are to a church what truth is to the soul. They protect us from the harsh elements and give light to our path. Just two weeks after beginning this critical step in the building of the Institute's Provincial Shrine in the United States of America, the windows on the church's north side have been completely restored. With full ownership of this historic landmark edifice, the Institute of Christ the King is dedicated to building within its unshakable walls our national headquarters church to serve as "our cathedral" for our mission and work in the United States of America. This beautiful Renaissance style building has ten massive windows, which magnificently illuminate the church's interior. We are restoring the original frames and replacing the panes with ¼" laminated glass, which will not only seal up the building's existing exterior, but will also serve as protective glass for the future stained glass.
