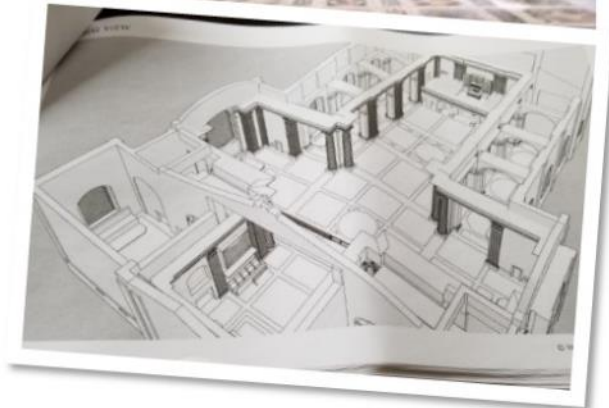
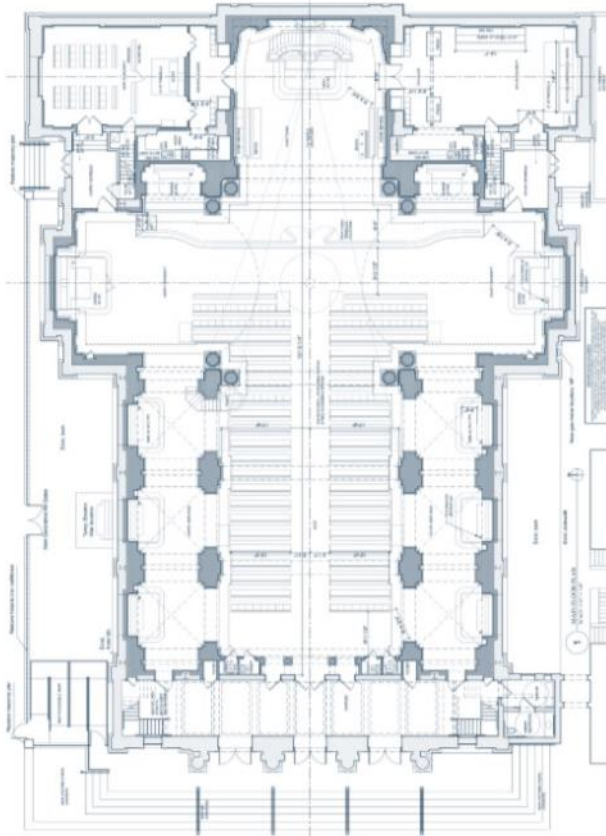
From the Vice-Rector, the Reverend Canon Commins
