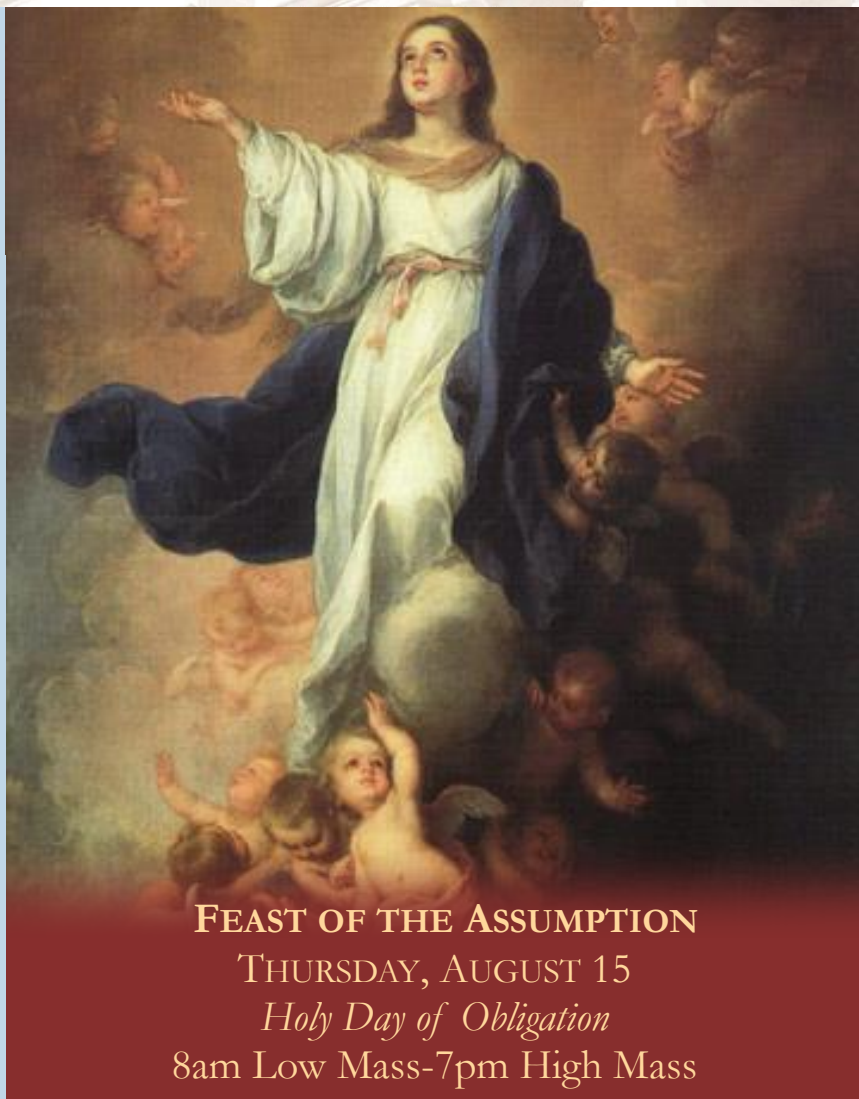

Top to bottom, inside as well as out, we are making sure this historic landmark church will be as strong as the day she was built. The walls of this magnificent church were constructed nearly 100 years ago! That’s why we’re taking great care to ensure they stay strong for the next century and beyond.

Local stone workers are cleaning and tuckpointing the 1923 interior brick walls so they are like brand new for 2023!

Over time, the mortar that holds bricks together will begin to deteriorate, causing the integrity of the walls to slowly become compromised. As we prepare to build out these walls in order to create the dynamic interior dimensions, we want to make sure the original brick is both strong and clean. No shortcuts. No excuses.

First, all of the brick is cleaned for optimal air quality. Then, all of the mortar is grinded out and replaced to make the walls as strong as the day they were built.
