FROM OUR RECTOR, CANON MATTHEW TALARICO

Dear faithful of the Shrine,

As the year grows from summer into autumn, so also are there transitions here at 6415 South Woodlawn in this beloved spiritual home which houses both the Shrine local apostolate as well as the provincial headquarters for the Institute of Christ the King in the United States.

Having faithfully served in Chicago and in the Institute's American province as bursar for the past five years, Canon Joel Estrada will now be appointed as Rector of a new apostolate out East which will soon be announced in coordination with the local diocese. On Sunday, October 13, a farewell reception will be held for Canon after the Masses so that we can all thank him for his generous dedication and wish him well as the "founding father" of the Institute's newest apostolate.

We are happy to welcome newly-ordained Canon James Hoogerwerf, who will offer Holy Mass on Sunday, September 15. A native of Rock Island, Illinois, Canon Hoogerwerf would drive in to Chicago back in 2009 in order to attend the First Saturday Mornings of Recollection at the Shrine. Since the administration of the American provincial headquarters and of the Shrine local apostolate both continue to develop, more office help is needed with these tasks which have grown to be too numerous for one person. Thus, Mrs. Mary Hall, who has most generously worked for the Institute for over 23 years, will now focus on the office administration for the Institute nationally on the provincial level, while Miss Amilia Raciunas is now taking on office duties as the Shrine's Secretary for all matters pertaining to the local Chicago apostolate. We thank these two very capable and committed ladies for their invaluable service which benefits us all!
