A Foundation for Our Future



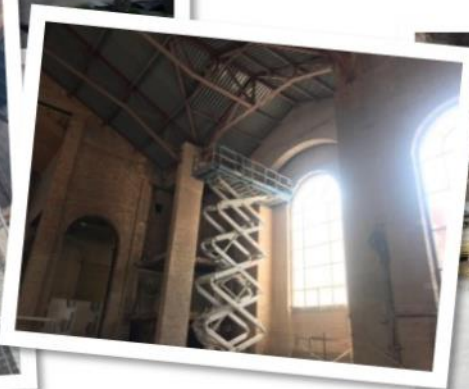
The Shrine of Christ the King was meant to stand the tests of time — and we want to make sure of it!
