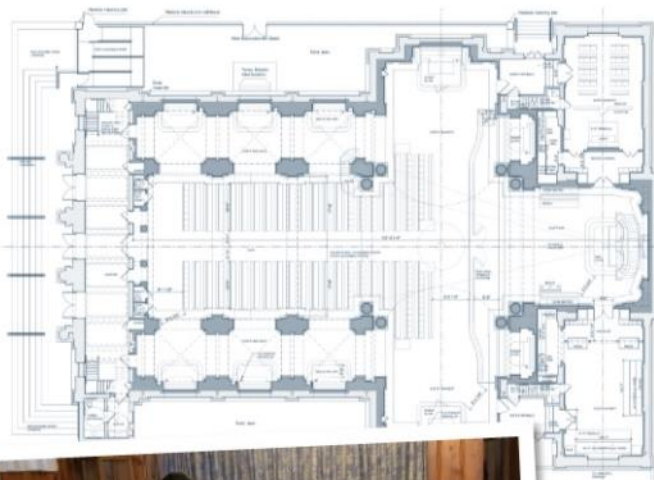
# *Contemporary Comfort within a* **CLASSICAL DESIGN**
