FROM OUR SHRINE'S VICE-RECTOR, CANON JEAN-BAPTISTE COMMINS:

It is a breach of courtesy to be unpunctual. A very provoking weakness of character is an inability to be on time. It can do much harm when tardiness repeatedly inconveniences others. There are many occasions in your life when punctuality means a great deal to your friends. If you are dependable, you will be punctual and conscientious about fulfilling commitments. When you have promised to meet a friend at a certain hour in a certain place, or when you have promised to render a certain service by a given time, you are really testing your character. If you are undependable, you will often make others wait for you and permit a number of things to interfere with your promptness in fulfilling your word. The plans and arrangements of one person are very often dependent on the word or conscientiousness of others. **Complications can result from failure to keep appointments promptly, and all who are inconvenienced by the delay cannot help but form an unfavorable judgment about the one who failed.** You show discourtesy and weakness of character if you find that you are frequently making excuses to others because you put them out by not keeping appointments; if you are careless about making mental or written note of the exact time when you are expected to meet someone else; if you are easily diverted from definite obligations to others by chance meetings or conversations or passing interests; if you consider punctuality of little importance; or if you are in the habit of putting off preparations to keep appointments until it becomes impossible to be on time. You are uncharitable if you are not on time. Dependability is tested in the routine matters of charity, little deeds of service that friends undertake to perform for one another as a matter of course in daily life. Let us then make a particular effort to be on time for the most important appointment of our lives: The Mass!

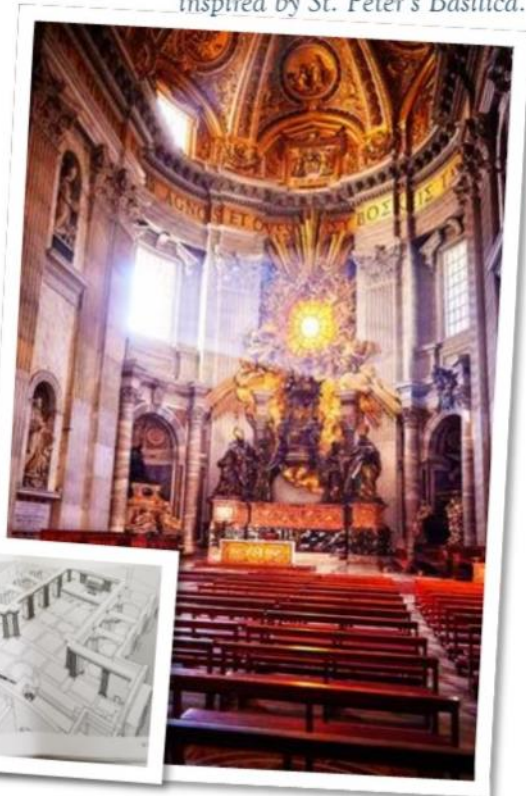
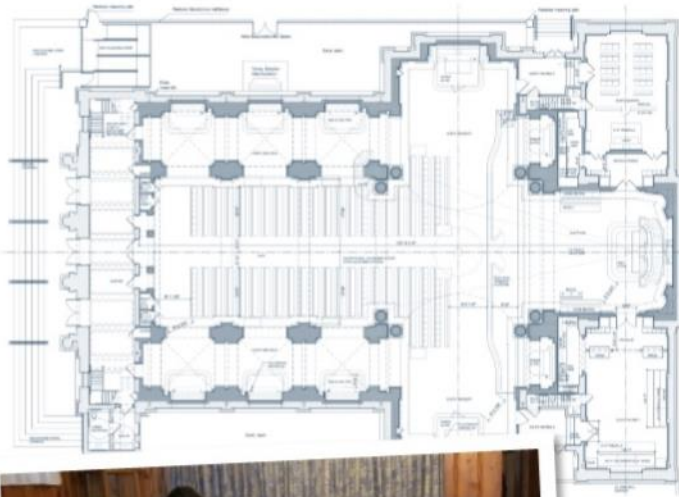
Contemporary Comfort within a **CLASSICAL DESIGN**
