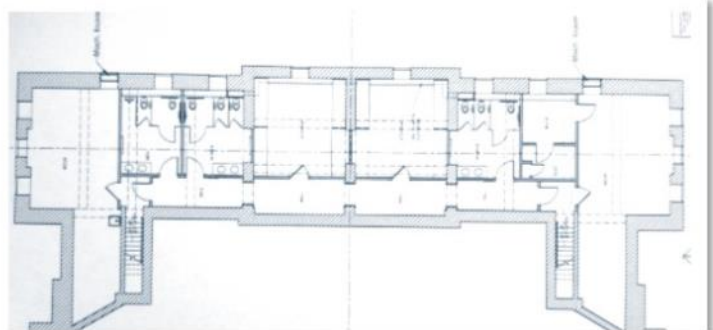

# *Digging Deep at Year's End* **BASEMENT EXCAVATION**

This past week, while the weather got cold, we went underground and began the excavation of the church's original unfinished basement to make room for storage and community spaces as well as the restroom facilities for the future Shrine. With the ceiling only about 7 feet high (6 feet in some places), we will lower the floor about 2 feet in order to make a safe and comfortable space for the many pilgrims who will visit once the future Shrine of Christ the King is complete.
