FROM THE VICE-RECTOR, CANON COMMINS

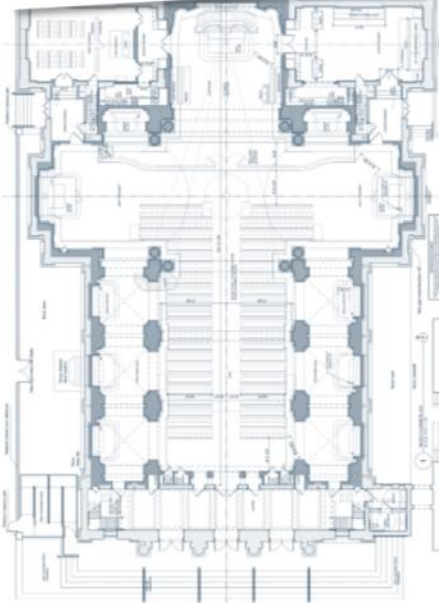
Dear Faithful,
