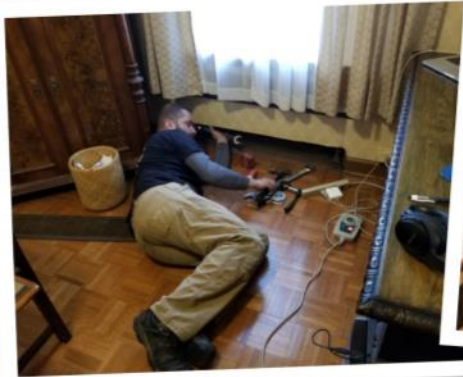
PROVINCIAL SHRINE: *Preparing the Floor*

This past week, workers continued to prepare for interior construction by removing the church's original, marble tile sanctuary floor. The damaged floor was removed to expose the original concrete slab, which also will be replaced to provide a new sub floor for the Shrine's new sanctuary, modeled after that of St. Peter's Basilica.

In the Provincial Headquarters building next door, repairs and remodeling continue with the replacing of old steam traps with new ones to improve the efficiency of the heating system. This building is where the priests who administer to the Institute's entire U.S. Province both live and work each day. Thank you for your continued support!
