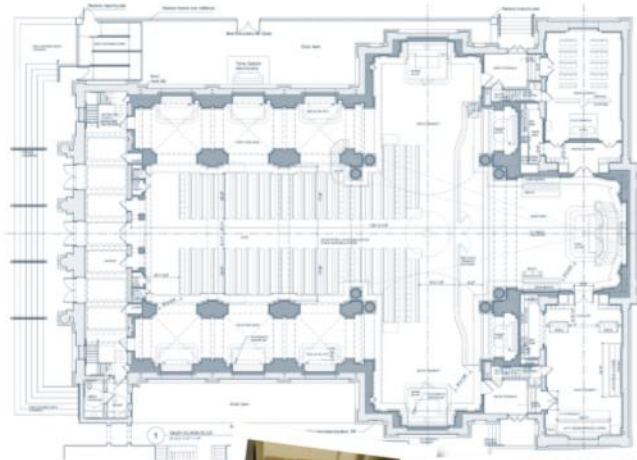
PROVINCIAL SHRINE:
