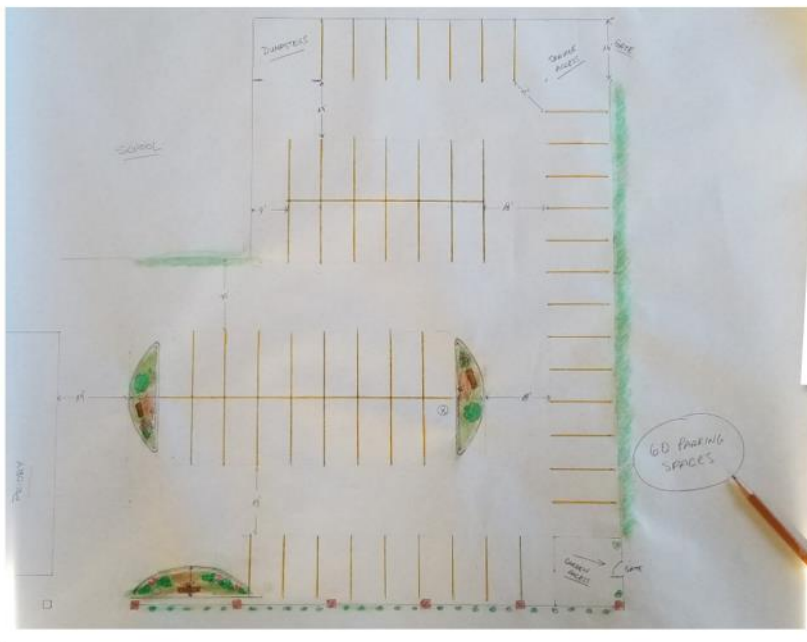
# U.S. PROVINCIAL SHRINE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN
