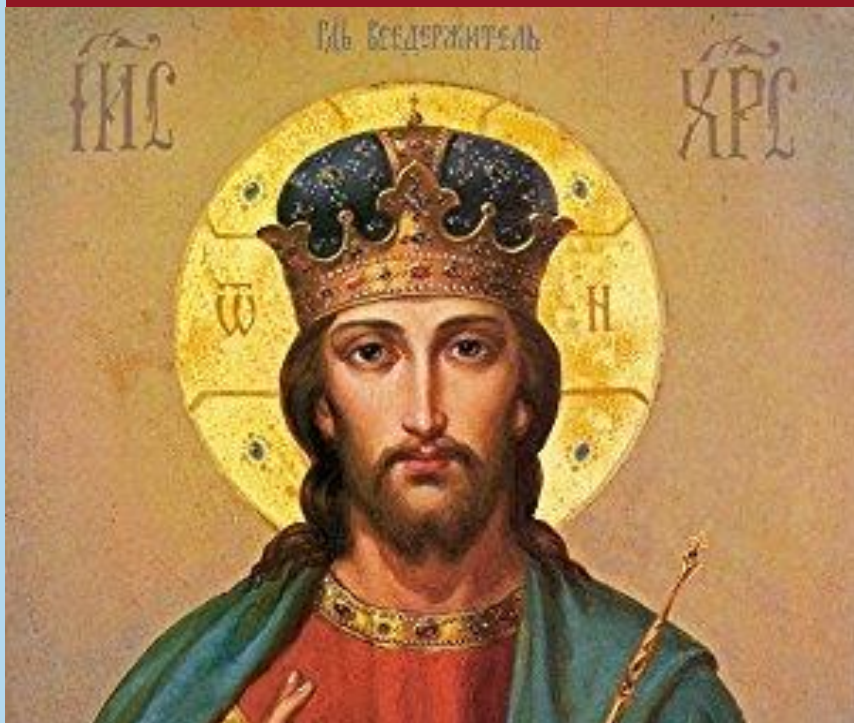

This past summer, we asked your help to renovate the parking lot so that we would have a welcoming and inviting place for everyone who comes to the Shrine. As you can see, a beautiful new fence and gate have been installed, and islands with greenery and lighting are being put into place. For good drainage, the lot needed to be properly graded and the many layers of pavement needed to be completely removed. This particular part of the project proved to be more involved because we discovered a former building's foundation wall, which needed to be removed from the ground. New asphalt will soon be laid, and after the new parking lot surface has been able to set and cure appropriately, lines will be painted for each space. When all will be ready, we can then reopen the new and improved parking lot and enjoy the rewarding results of all this hard work.

Today, dear faithful, I am deeply grateful and proud of you for having made this extraordinary financial sacrifice. During the months of July, August, September, and even now into October, so many of you answered our call to double your Sunday offering each week in order to help finance the new parking lot. By your dedicated commitment to doubling your weekly contribution over these months, we have raised nearly \$30,000 more than last year at this time, helping to make this new parking lot possible.
