We are accepting Mass intentions (preferably without any specific date) for next year. Please know that our Mass Intention Book is already full through May. We are first asking for a soft limit of 6 intentions a year per family (including 2 Sunday Masses a year) in order to accommodate everyone's requests & gradually accept more, if permitting. Suggested Mass stipend is \$10 for each intention (this stipend, or whichever the requestor gives, benefits the priest celebrating the Mass for his livelihood). In addition, Mass intention requests must now be accompanied with the stipend in order for the requests be actually reserved & scheduled in the Mass intention book.

First Friday 7pm Public Masses are exclusively offered for our Shrine Groups Intentions 9:00 AM Low Masses on Sundays are exclusively offered for our Shrine Benefactors.

Christmas Novena Masses (Christmas Eve through New Year's Day) are exclusively offered for those enrolled in this Novena.

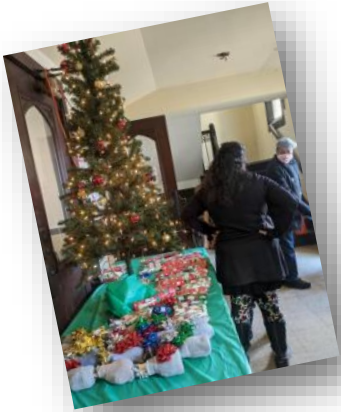
