Reception of Holy Communion

In the Traditional Mass, Holy Communion is offered exclusively on the tongue by the priest. This is offered in a safe and “*contactless*” manner, but to ensure that this is done with ease the communicant must follow the following guidelines:

- Stick out your tongue slightly while your head is tilted back slightly.
- Do not move your head while the priest is trying to give you Communion.
- Wait for the host to be placed on your tongue and the priest’s hand is away from your mouth before closing your mouth.
- Do **not** say “Amen “ before or after receiving our Lord as this may cause difficulty for the priest giving you Communion.

As we enter the homestretch of the Advent season, we have great news for our Institute family in the United States. After over two years of preparation at St. Francis de Sales Priory in St. Louis (and despite delays related to the virus situation and impossibility of international travel), our two oblate candidates will make their commitment as oblate brothers of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest.

Mark Halisky and Lance Gerbig will receive the cassock on **Wednesday, January 20, 2021** at St. Francis de Sales Oratory in St. Louis, Missouri.

Thank you for joining me in praying for our confreres as they prepare to make this important consecration of their lives to the service of Holy Mother Church within the family of the Institute.

MASS REQUEST

We are accepting Mass intentions (preferably without any specific date) for next year. Please know that our Mass Intention Book is already full through May. We are first asking for a soft limit of 6 intentions a year per family (including 2 Sunday Masses a year) in order to accommodate everyone’s requests & gradually accept more, if permitting. Suggested Mass stipend is \$10 for each intention (this stipend, or whichever the requestor gives, benefits the priest celebrating the Mass for his livelihood). In addition, Mass intention requests must now be accompanied with the stipend in order for the requests be actually reserved & scheduled in the Mass intention book.

First Friday 7pm Public Masses are exclusively offered for our Shrine Groups Intentions 9:00 AM Low Masses on Sundays are exclusively offered for our Shrine Benefactors.

Christmas Novena Masses (Christmas Eve through New Year's Day) are exclusively offered for those enrolled in this Novena.
