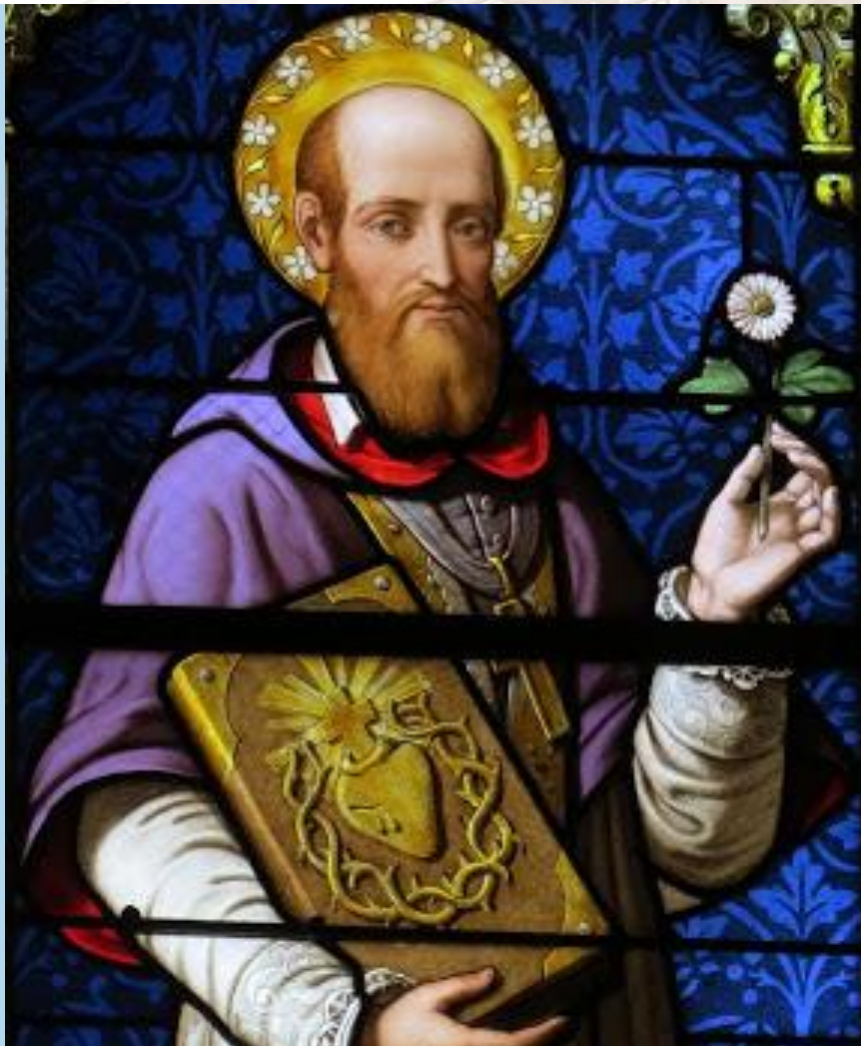

BEAUTY FROM ASHES, WITH GRATITUDE TO BENEFACTOR 'SAVE THE SHRINE'

The Institute of Christ the King is grateful for the support of local nonprofit organization, Save the Shrine, which recently awarded \$90,0000 to the Institute. The purpose of this generous grant is for the restoration of the church of the Shrine of Christ the King, a historic landmark in the Woodlawn neighborhood of Chicago, after it suffered a devastating fire in October 2015. This final contribution from Save the Shrine has funded the final work of Phase I of the three-phase plan to fully restore the Shrine into the Spiritual Stronghold that will serve the Institute as the Provincial Headquarters in the United States. As the young Institute continues to grow nationwide, having a Provincial Headquarters is critical in continuing the vision to restore Catholic life and culture in America.

The mission of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest is to spread the reign of Christ in all spheres of human life by drawing from the millennial treasury of the Roman Catholic Church, particularly her liturgical tradition, the unbroken line of spiritual thought and practice of her saints, and her cultural patrimony in music, art and architecture.

The Institute accomplishes this primarily through a solid and well-rounded formation of its priests, rooted in Catholic tradition and carried out at its international seminary in the Archdiocese of Florence. The Institute's priests, conscious of the need for their own sanctification, strive to be instruments of God's grace through their apostolic work discharged in the churches assigned to the Institute, its schools, its missions in Africa, by preaching retreats, teaching catechesis, and providing spiritual guidance. The Institute of Christ the King operates under the patronage of the Immaculate Conception, to Whom it is consecrated.

Inspired by the love, piety, and devotion of those who have gone before us, those who have handed down to us the treasure of our Faith, and those who continue in the present day to demonstrate generosity and charity, the interior of the Institute's Provincial Shrine of Christ the King will reflect the majesty and beauty of heaven.

The Institute looks forward to completing the next two phases, including realizing the magnificent designs of architect William Heyer. The classical basilica-style interior will reflect the genius of Henry Schlacks' original vision to bring the beauty of Rome to the United States. Heyer has embellished the interior design with details inspired by some of the most beautiful churches ever built by the hands of men. For the love of our Divine King, the Provincial Shrine of Christ the King will unite both time and place with eternity to serve and adore our Lord Jesus Christ now and forever.

Contributing to the success of the progress made on the restoration of the church are the generosity of the Institute's benefactors, the steadfast work of contractors, and the continued prayers and patience of its local faithful. The Institute is deeply grateful to the benevolence of Divine Providence and to these main stakeholders, including Save the Shrine, who have demonstrated their care and support at the Institute's most urgent times of need and now at the close of one phase of restoration and beginning the next.
