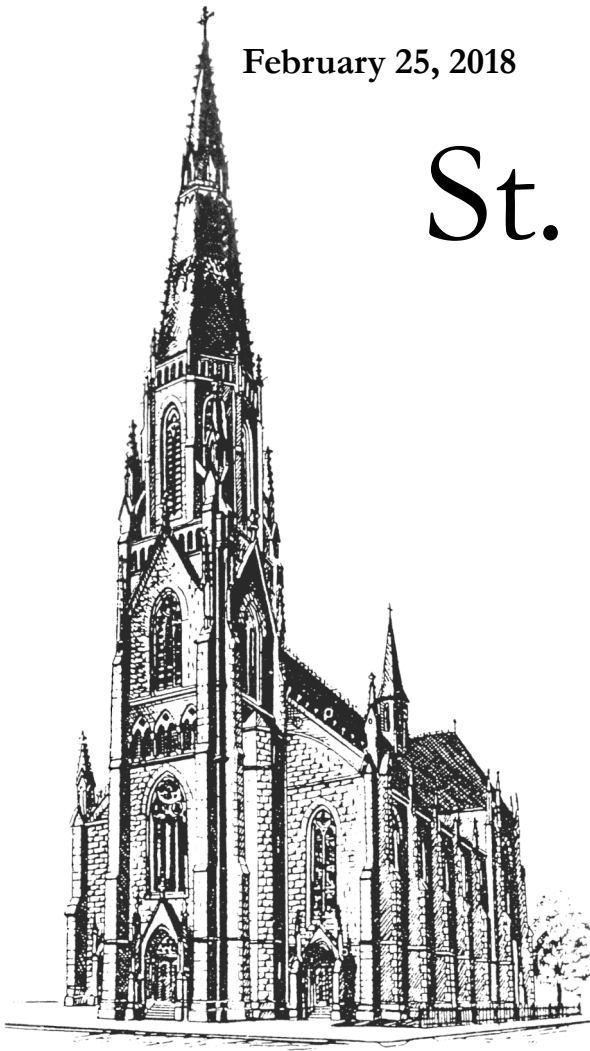

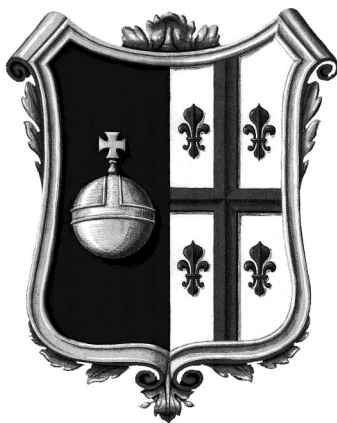


## FROM THE RECTOR: CANON STEIN
