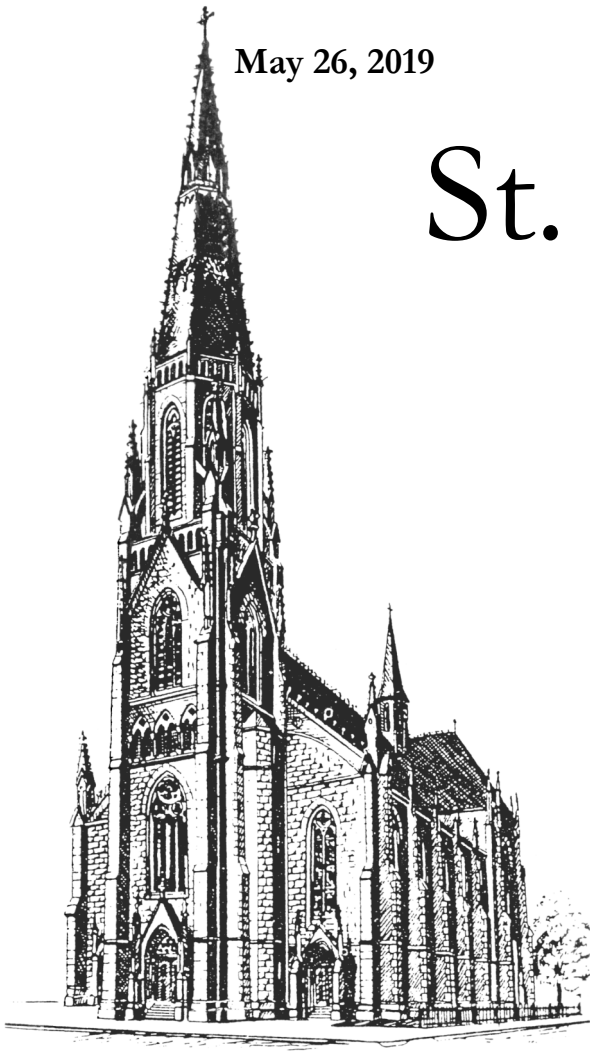

### **Did you know?**

... that on October 11, 1954, Pope Pius XII, through the encyclical *Ad caeli Reginam*, instituted the Feast of the Queenship of Mary to be celebrated on May 31 of every year. Our Lady is Queen for two reasons: her Divine Motherhood and her exceptional role in the work of our eternal salvation. From His Conception in the womb of the Blessed Virgin, Our Lord was as man King and Lord of all things, Our Lady is Queen. Moreover, Jesus is not only King by His Birth, but also by His deeds. He acquired this right of Kingship over all creation by the act of redemption upon the Cross. In this work, Our Lady was His closest associate, as His mother, she offered up Her Son for our redemption with the complete sacrifice of her maternal rights and maternal love. For this reason too, she is Queen of Heaven and Queen of the World. Just as a virgin had been closely associated with the death of the human race, so a Virgin was associated with its redemption. As His associate in the work of redemption, she has a share in a limited and analogous way in His royal dignity.
