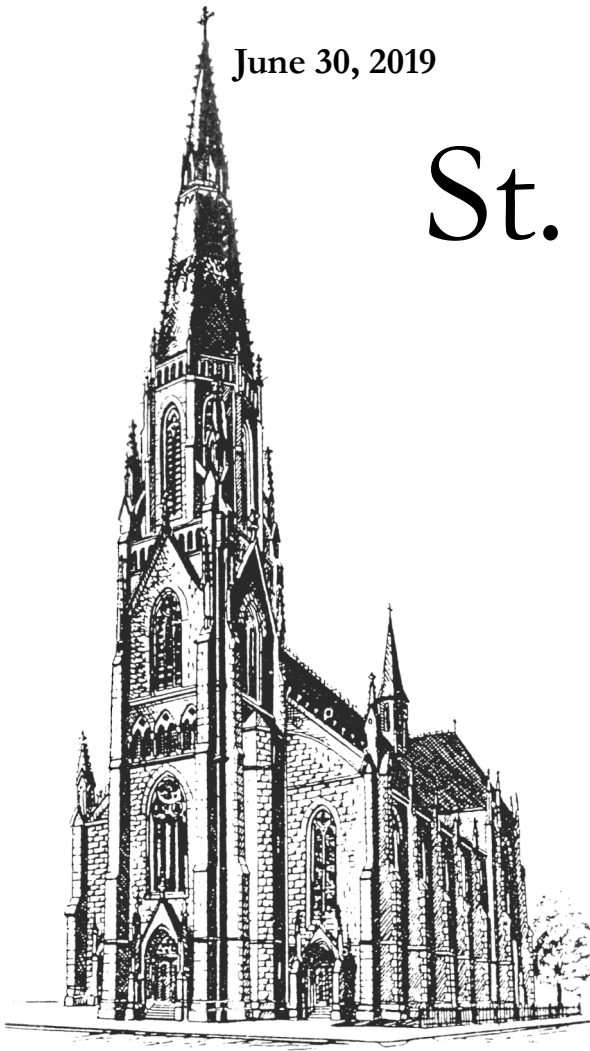

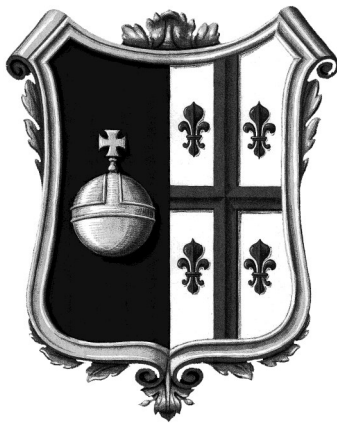

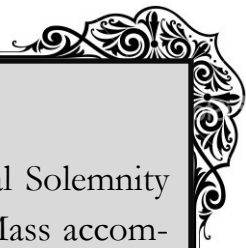
Dear Oratory Faithful,
