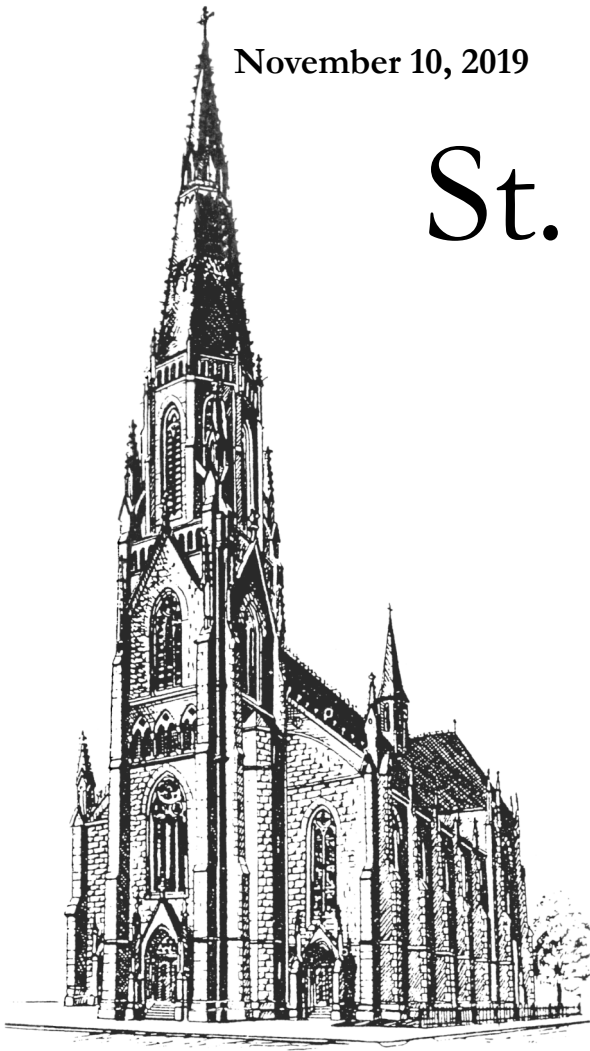

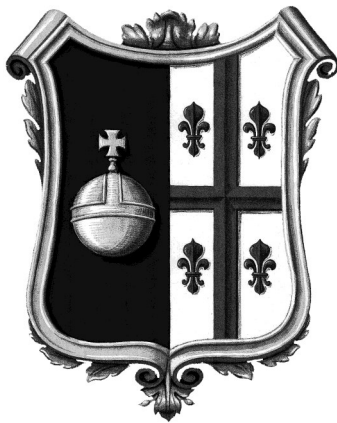

### **Did you know?**

... that November 9, was the dedication of the Basilica of Saint John Lateran, the only Archbasilica in the world. Ranking higher than Saint Peter Basilica, it is the cathedral church of the Diocese of Rome and the seat of its Bishop, the Roman Pontiff. Its full title is the *Cathedral of the Most Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and the Evangelist in the Lateran*. An inscription on the side identifies the Sacred Church as the Mother and Head of all the Churches in the city and the world. The high altar, a wooden one now encased in stone, was used by Saint Peter, the first Pope. In the apse of the church is the *cathedra* or chair of the Pope symbolizing his infallibility when speaking on matters of faith and morals. The vigil of Easter began there with a procession to Saint Peter for the service.

**Faithful/Obedient Giving** = Precept of the Church (Operating Fund)

**Generous Giving** = Historic Renewal Campaign (Restoration Fund)

**Heroic Giving** = Sacrifice (How all of Christendom was built)
