## ABOUT ST. JOSEPH SHRINE

A magnificent Victorian Gothic edifice completed in 1873 and noted as of national architectural significance, St. Joseph Shrine is a landmark center of Catholic Faith, culture, and community in Detroit's historic Eastern Market district. Since October 2016, the Canons of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest have served and led the local faithful by bringing daily Masses, regular devotions, liturgical instruction, and an active parish life. As a result, the parish community at St. Joseph Shrine continues to grow, enriching both young and old, individuals and families from all backgrounds and neighborhoods.

In July 2013, St. Joseph was merged with two nearby parishes. Then in October 2016, St. Joseph became its own parish under the spiritual and pastoral care of the Institute of Christ the King. **In March 2020, the Parish was granted the designation of Archdiocesan Shrine** in recognition of its vibrant spiritual growth and daily life.

The *Rorate Mass* is a Votive Mass in honor of the Virgin Mary for the season of Advent. It is called so after its introit. It has a long tradition in the Catholic Church, especially in German-speaking areas. The Masses had begin relatively early in the morning when it is still dark and are said by candlelight. The *Rorate Mass* was also known in the Middle Ages as the *Missa aurea*, and the *Missa Angelica*.

### **DID YOU KNOW?**

... that to acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary to perform the work to which the indulgence is attached and to fulfill the following three conditions: Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Sovereign Pontiff. These intentions of the Pope are specifically four in number:

1. The progress of the Faith and triumph of the Church;
2. Peace and union among Christian Princes and Rulers;
3. The conversion of sinners;
4. The uprooting of heresy.

They may be completed within a few days before or after the indulgenced act. It is further required that all attachment to sin, even venial sin, be absent.
